Supervision is a psychological process that enables practitioners to focus on personal and professional development. It offers a safe, confidential and reflective space for the practitioner to review their trauma and mental health informed work with children. The facilitation of a problem-solving approach will enable practitioners to consider alternative strategies to support children and teenagers. The primary aim of the supervision is to support the practitioner's work with vulnerable children and, in so doing, support the practitioner.
