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

The School Support section highlights information for all schools and settings. Our new section for the Whole School Approach features useful tools and resources.

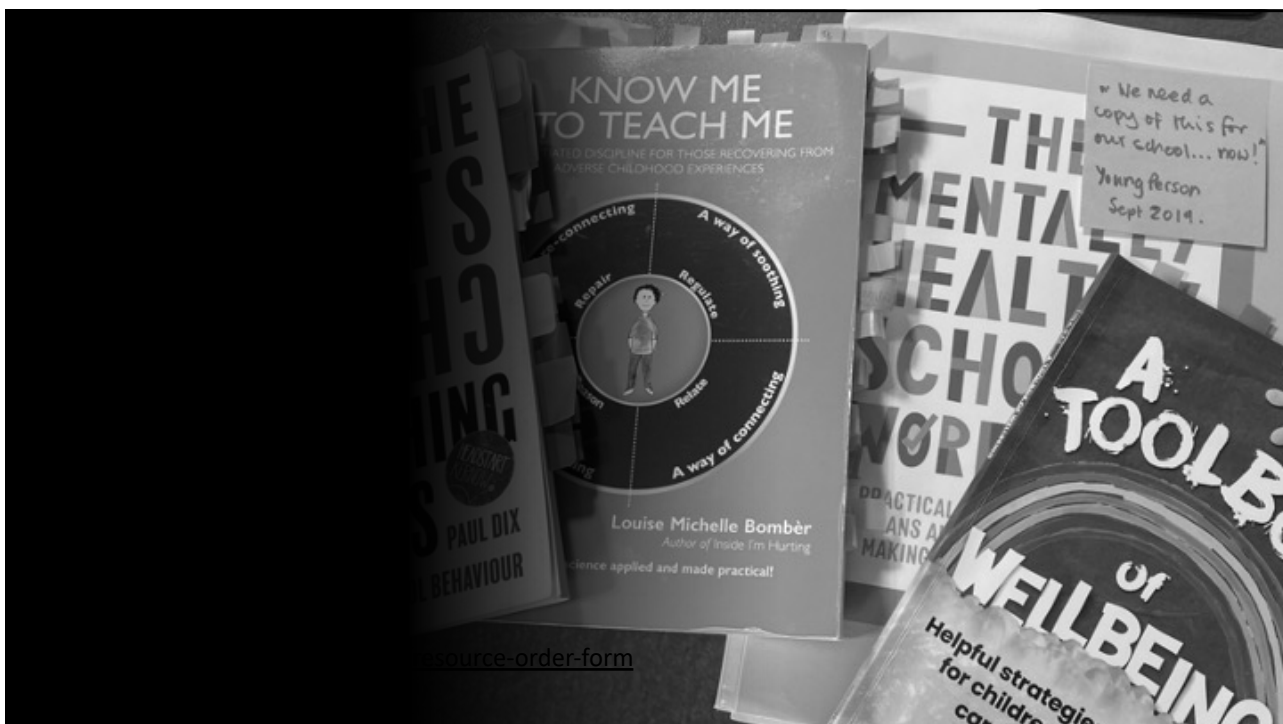

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Help and support

- Do you know how to raise a concern about a child in school?
 - Safeguarding lead / pastoral team / Trauma Informed practitioner.
- Part of a WSA is for everyone to be able / confident to recognise when a child is struggling and know who / how to refer in school
- It is unlikely that individual staff would need to refer outside of school but worth knowing what is available...

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Early Help Hub

- The 'front door' to Early Help services led by Cornwall Council and Cornwall Foundation Trust.
- Staff within the Early Help Hub will decide whether the child / young person is eligible for support and which service is most appropriate. This is usually in discussion with the person making the request and / or young person / family.
